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#### **Excursions of your cruise**

An artist once had the idea to turn the village of San Sperate into a giant canvas. Now it's a veritable open air museum, where you can admire striking Day 3 - Sunday Cagliari / Street art and optical illusions at almost every turn. After walking around the village, it's time to visit a wine estate. Enjoy a wine tasting accompanied by local delicacies Sardinian tastes (1/2 day) \* at the home of some of Sardinia's best wines. 1/2 day. Bus, truck and visit on foot Europe's highest volcano (3,323 m) has an impressive record: over 140 full-scale eruptions, and every year new Day 7 - Thursday volcanic activity disrupts the physionomy of the terrain. Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.
