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Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday Split	Its founder, the Roman Emperor Diocletian, had a huge palace built, from which the city gradually developed. It is one of the largest and most fascinating Roman ruins in the world. Ship docked in port.
Day 2 - Sunday Zadar	This peninsular city, known for its Roman and Venetian ruins, holds two thousand years of history within its walls: a Roman forum, baroque treasures, Romanesque churches as well as its ancient fortifications. Ship at anchor. Water sports.
Day 3 - Monday Piran	Located on a craggy peninsula with a baroque bell-tower that soars above the ochre rooftops of its ancient buildings, the narrow cobbled streets and little port, this is one of the prettiest towns on the Slovenian coast. Ship at anchor, water sports available.
Day 4 - Tuesday Venice	The City of Water is a fascinating blend of architectural styles, its soul intimately woven into its labyrinth of narrow streets and canals, its palaces and bell towers, squares and churches. Ship docked.
Day 5 - Wednesday Venice	On the water, in the narrow streets or behind the gorgeous facades of its palaces, La Serenissima is a living museum city packed with unique works of art. Ship docked, no water sports.
Day 6 - Thursday Opatija	Located at the back of the Kvarner Gulf, the stunning houses that line the 11 kilometres of the Lungomare promenade give this seaside resort, which was very fashionable in the 19th century, a look of the Côte d'Azur. Ship at anchor, water sports available.
Day 7 - Friday Pula	This city has a wealth of ancient Roman buildings and an exceptional architectural heritage including some real jewels of Antiquity: mosaics, temples, a stunning amphitheatre and forum which have formed the heart of the city for twenty centuries. Ship at anchor, water sports available.
Day 8 - Saturday Split	Its founder, the Roman Emperor Diocletian, had a huge palace built, from which the city gradually developed. It is one of the largest and most fascinating Roman ruins in the world. Ship docked in port.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.
