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#### Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday Split	Its founder, the Roman Emperor Diocletian, had a huge palace built, from which the city gradually developed. It is one of the largest and most fascinating Roman ruins in the world. Ship docked in port.	
Day 2 - Sunday Mljet	Legend has it this "green island" was the home of Calypso. Today it is a national park. Its two inland lakes linked to the sea, from which arises a Benedictine monastery, create a breathtaking natural spectacle. Ship at anchor, water sports available.	
Day 3 - Monday Dubrovnik	The ramparts provide a fabulous view over the sublime city centre, where every stone tells a story. The marble pavements and city lights contribute to the animation of this museum-city. Ship at anchor. Beach.	
Day 4 - Tuesday Kotor	At the end of Europe's largest fjord, which stretches a full 30 kms (19 miles) inland, and towering some 300 yards over the sea, the fortifications of Kotor protect this city, marked by the stamp of Venitian architecture. Ship docked in port.	
Day 5 - Wednesday Vlore		
Day 6 - Thursday Corfu	A coveted location at the gateway to the Adriatic, beautifully green mountains with creeks of white sand and a Venitian-style fortified town give it its or quite unique identity. Ship docked in port.	
Day 7 - Friday Gallipoli		
Day 8 - Saturday Brindisi	This ancient port city of Imperial Rome was the gateway to the Orient and a point of departure for the crusaders. The old town faces out to the horizon and is full of churches basilicas, fountains and oratories. Ship docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid. Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise. The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.
