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### Itinerary of your cruise

Day 1 - Saturday Brindisi	This ancient port city of Imperial Rome was the gateway to the Orient and a point of departure for the crusaders. The old town faces out to the horizon and is full of churches basilicas, fountains and oratories. Ship docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call. This wild and craggy island with its peaceful villages, little churches with their bell towers showing the Venetian influence, and unspoilt inlets make this a less well-known destination. Ship at anchor, water sports available.			
Day 2 - Sunday Island of Vis				
Day 3 - Monday Venice	The City of Water is a fascinating blend of architectural styles, its soul intimately woven into its labyrinth of narrow streets and canals, its palaces and bell towers, squares and churches. Ship docked.			
Day 4 - Tuesday Piran	Located on a craggy peninsula with a baroque bell-tower that soars above the ochre rooftops of its ancient buildings, the narrow cobbled streets and port, this is one of the prettiest towns on the Slovenian coast. Ship at anchor, water sports available.			
Day 5 - Wednesday island of Cres	From colourful hamlets to beautiful beaches via the cliffs with their unspoilt wildlife, the biggest island in the Adriatic and Croatia offers travellers unforgettable scenery. Ship at anchor, water sports available.			
Day 6 - Thursday Trogir	This "little Venice" is a UNESCO World Heritage site that was the envy of many peoples before being annexed by the Venetians in 1420. The Gothic houses and Renaissance palaces that line its narrow, winding streets bear traces of the past. Ship at anchor, water sports available.			
Day 7 - Friday Kockula	Founded in the 12th century BC by the Trojan hero Antenor, the history of Korcula has been enriched by a succession of civilizations: Greek, Roman,			

 KUKUG	Illyrian, Croat and Venetian. "Little Dubrovnik" is also said to be the birthplace of Marco Polo. Ship at anchor, water sports available.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.
